Fees: There is a \$35.00 non-refundable application fee

Work Program- \$20.00 a day

NOTICE: It may take two weeks to process your application. Persons waiting until the last few days to turn in an application will be told to report to the jail as ordered by the Court. It is the applicant's responsibility to contact the jail and set a report date to the jail.

***Be aware that the court order approving Alternative Sentencing does not mean that you will be accepted to a program. The determination is made by the Sheriff's Department and is based on you meeting our requirements. The Court may recommend, restrict or deny your participation in any program.

WORK PROGRAM (WP) :

This program is for persons sentenced to serve 60 days or less.

GOOD TIME OR WORK TIME CREDITS WILL NOT BE GIVEN.

Participants are to report at least 2 days per week unless given prior approval. 8 hours of labor will equal one 24 hour jail day.

THE FIRST DAY SHALL BE DURING THE REGULAR WORKWEEK, TUESDAY-THURSDAY. All subsequent days can be served any day of the week seven days a week.

The use of prescription medication during work program hours that would impair physical or mental condition, affecting safety at the work site may be cause for denial. There are other qualifications associated with this program.
