

IMMEDIATELY AFTER COURT YOU MUST DO THE FOLLOWING:

1. Go to the **CLERK'S OFFICE**. Get the court's order in writing. You need this written information to apply for alternative sentencing and to set up a payment plan. The Clerk's Office is located at:

NOTICE TO DEFENDANT OF FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY
AND OBLIGATION FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF COUNTY COSTS
AND CIVIL LIABILITY FOR RESTITUTION

At the conclusion of your case the court may require that you pay the following amounts:

1. ATTORNEY'S FEES, to reimburse the county for the cost of providing legal services for your defense. (Penal Code Section 987.8 and Govt. Code Section 22712)
2. PRESENTENCE PROBATION REPORT, to reimburse the county or the costs of preparing your probation report. (Penal Code Section 1203.1(b))
3. CONFINEMENT COSTS, to reimburse the county for the costs while you were in custody. (Penal Code Section 1203.1(c) and 1209.
4. DIVERSION COSTS, to reimburse the county for the cost of providing drug diversion services. (Penal Code Section 1001.15 and 1001.16.

In order to determine your ability to pay all or a portion of the above costs, the court will order you to appear before a county financial evaluation officer. In that review, you have the following rights and obligations:

1. The right to a statement of all costs ordered as soon as it is available.
2. The right to dispute the evaluation of your ability to pay at a hearing before the court pursuant to Govt. Code Section 27755 and Penal Code Section 1203.1c
3. You must report to Placer County Division of Revenue Services within five (5) days of your sentencing or within five (5) of your release from custody.

If you fail to appear for a financial evaluation, the Revenue Service Division will recommend that the Court order you to pay such costs in full. Orders entered under these provisions have the same force and effect as a judgment in a civil action and shall be subject to enforcement against your property in the same manner as any other money judgments.

NOTICE TO DEFENDANT REGARDING CIVIL LIABILITY FOR RESTITUTION
PENAL CODE SECTION 1214

YOU ARE HERBY NOTIFIED that in any case in which you are ordered to pay restitution as a condition of probation or of a conditional sentence, including where restitution is required by Penal Code Section 1203.4, the order to pay restitution is deemed a money judgment if you are informed of your right to have a judicial determination of the amount and are provided with a hearing, waive a hearing, or stipulate to the amount of the restitution ordered and shall constitute a civil judgment enforceable in the same manner as is provided for the enforcement of any other money judgment.

PROMISE TO APPER: DEFENDANT BEING RELEASED AGREES THAT:

1. Defendant will appear at all times and places as ordered by the court or magistrate before who the charge is subsequently pending.
 2. Defendant promises to obey all reasonable conditions imposed by the court or magistrate.
 3. Defendant promises not to leave the State of California without permission of the court.
 4. Defendant agrees to waive extradition if defendant fails to appear as required and is apprehended outside the State of California and agrees that he/she may be returned forthwith to the State of California upon apprehension.
 5. Defendant acknowledges being informed of the consequences and penalties applicable to a failure to appear or a violation of any conditions of release, including prosecution for the crime of failure to appear and immediate return to custody.
 6. Defendant shall submit person, place of residence, vehicle or area over which he/she has control to search and seizure at any time, day or night, with or without a search warrant, and with or without reasonable cause, by the probation officer or any peace officer for the purpose of determining compliance with conditions of release.
 7. Submit to drug, narcotic or alcohol testing as directed by the probation officer or any peace officer.
 8. Not possess or use any narcotic or controlled substance without a valid medical prescription.
- Domestic Violence Temporary Restraining Order:
- 1 Defendant shall not directly or indirectly, contact, molest, harass, attack, strike, threaten, sexually assault, batter, telephone, send any messages to, follow, stalk, destroy the personal property of, or disturb the peace of the victim.
 - 2 Defendant must immediately move from the victim's residence.
 - 3 Defendant shall stay at least 100 yards away from the victim.
 - 4 Defendant shall have no visitation with child/children until hearing.
