ALTERNATIVE SENTENCING PROGRAMS

Electronic Monitoring Program, Work Furlough, Drug Court/Track III, and the Adult Day Reporting Center have been established by the Placer County Probation Department as alternatives to incarceration for those who qualify.

If you qualify for the Drug Court Track III Substance Abuse Program you will be assessed for placement in a one-year program. The level of treatment is based on the type of care you require. After you complete treatment, your jail sentence will be considered served. Participants will be assessed for the ability to pay for the cost of the treatment on a sliding scale basis.

If you qualify for the Adult Work Release Program, and have a sentence of 60 days or less, you continue to live at your home and exchange each day of your jail sentence for a day of work. Public work sites are located in various areas of the county. The work is labor oriented and is available Saturdays and Sundays, during daylight hours. Some mid-week programs are also available. It is available 7 days per week in Tahoe. You must provide your own transportation to and from the job site.

If you qualify for the Electronic Monitoring Program (EMP/GPS), and have a minimum of 30 actual days remaining on your sentence (60 days or more in Tahoe), you will serve your jail sentence in your home by wearing a tamper-proof electronic surveillance device (ankle bracelet) 24-hours a day. In most cases you may continue to work, attend school, or care for children in the home.

If you qualify for the Adult Day Reporting Center (ADRC/GPS), and have a jail sentence less than 180 days, you may apply for the program from in or out of custody. Individuals with a sentence of 180 days or greater need to complete ½ of their sentence and be in custody at the time of jail pick up. ADRC is a 90 day program and participants will be required to wear a GPS Device. In addition, participants will be given the opportunity to obtain their GED, attend individual, group, & family counseling as directed, and utilize employment services at Golden Sierra Job Training Agency. Individuals who complete the program will be given credit for their disciplinary sentence.

If you are interested in any of the above programs, you must **IMMEDIATELY REPORT IN PERSON** to one of the offices listed below. Any delay in reporting will jeopardize your possible acceptance into a program. **YOU MUST BRING YOUR COURT ORDER. PLEASE REPORT TO:**
